### Online Teaching and Learning Virtual Focus Groups

In the early spring, New Mexico Junior College (NMJC) turned to CCCSE to conduct focus groups with students and faculty via Zoom to investigate how well remote learning was working at the college. As part of the project, CCCSE will also submit a report to the college summarizing the findings. In the video clips linked below, NMJC students share experiences from their online courses and college faculty give advice for transitioning to teaching in a virtual learning environment.

Last year, in collaboration with a special advisory committee, CCCSE created a stand-alone online survey designed to help colleges understand their students' experiences with racism, inclusion, and belonging. It is our hope that college leaders will use the resulting data to have conversations with their faculty and staff about how racial barriers impact community college students and the campus experience.

To give you an update, this spring,

110 colleges across 35 states
participated in the Race/Ethnicity
Pilot Survey free of charge,
alongside their CCSSE 2021
administration. Twenty-nine colleges
added the free, correllated items to
the faculty survey.
