



# **CCCSE's 20th Anniversary**

To kick off CCCSE's 20th anniversary, we are unveiling a fresh look, which includes a new logo. ## Fall College Visits to Collect Student Voices

Health protocols permitting, CCCSE plans to conduct recurring focus groups as part of the Listen to Me project (" ), revisiting the same Texas community college students three times over several months and tracking their progress. Listen to Me is funded by Greater Texas Foundation and will continue into January of 2022. Simultaneously, we will be conducting individual student interviews at three colleges as part of the Students in Need project (\*\*), jointly funded by ECMC Foundation and The Kresge Foundation.


